

College of Engineering Scholarships for Increased Participation in the Combined B.S.-M.S. Engineering Degree

The College of Engineering is pleased to announce the availability of funds to support undergraduate students who are admitted into their department's combined B.S.-M.S. degree. As a means of defraying the additional cost of tuition accompanying graduate student credit hours, COE will award scholarships of \$2000 each to students who are nominated by their department chair and selected by a College-wide committee composed of departmental graduate and undergraduate coordinators. **Students are eligible for this program if they meet the departmental criteria for and have applied to their department's B.S.-M.S. Degree Program this semester and will begin graduate-level coursework in the Spring 2010.**

Interested students should first apply to the combined B.S.-M.S. degree program following their department's guidelines. Students who are not aware of the departmental guidelines for application to the B.S.-M.S. degree program should consult with their undergraduate advisor and coordinator for more information. After application to the program, students will submit an application for a COE B.S.-M.S. Scholarship to their department chair. Applications can be obtained from undergraduate and graduate coordinators in each department. Department chairs will provide the College of Engineering a ranking of applicants from their respective department, using the following criteria:

- Application into the B.S.-M.S. degree program in the student's department
- Cumulative and Upper Division GPA
- Potential for success in the Master's program

A COE committee, composed of either the undergraduate or graduate coordinator from each department, will make the final selection of scholarship recipients. Because of the time restrictions in spending these funds, the following aggressive schedule is outlined:

- September 18, 2009—Scholarship application available to students.
- October 1, 2009—Departments provide name of COE B.S.-M.S. Scholarship Committee member (either the Undergraduate or Graduate Coordinator).
- October 5, 2009—Students submit scholarship application to department chairs.
- October 12, 2009—Department chairs provide COE a ranking of student applicants.
- October 19, 2009—COE B.S.-M.S. Scholarship Committee announces scholarship awardees. Students are notified.
- November 2, 2009—Advanced registration begins.
